Content

Bring Bolt Home

Meet Bolt, the electrical charge, who is lost on his circuit home and needs pupils' help to find his way. Listen to his safety stories, and work together to help him finish his journey. The pupils will adopt physical theatre techniques to move and work together to create a model of an electrical circuit, explaining how energy is transferred as well as discussing the safety precautions that we must take when using electricity.

Learning Level

Suitable for early, first and second stages with information and delivery adapted to the needs of your class.

Space

A large clear space, most suitable would be either a gym or assembly hall.

Time

Early/First – 60 minutes

Second – 90 minutes
