Eco-Schools: |Waste Minimisation and Litter|What a waste!

Content

In this session the participants will explore the idea of waste by finding out where materials come from and how they decompose and transfer nutrients. From gaining this information the participants will devise short scenes in groups relating to the ethos of reduce, reuse, recycle. In order to bring their dramatic pieces to life they will design and create props, set and costume from waste materials that are available for recycling. The session will conclude in a performance of their pieces that embody the idea of waste minimisation.

Learning Level

Suitable for early, first and second stages with information and delivery adapted to the needs of your class.

Space

A large clear space, most suitable would be either a gym or assembly hall.

Time

Early/First – 60 minutes

Second – 90 minutes

Additional Information

For the purpose of this workshop the pupils will need to collect their recycling in order to have enough material to make the costume and props necessary for the session. The materials can be anything from old clothes and books to bottles, newspapers or boxes. Please ensure that all the recycling is cleaned ready for use.
